We started piggybacking with the Calvary Riders and took the time to learn about MJM before we went off on our own. Now that we are out here, we hit the ground running.

We took part in a bike blessing hosted by Fred McClincy at the Mavericks club house. Some of you may remember this; it was the weekend of the Spring Kick-Off. We have teamed up with the Calvary Riders and had witnessing booths at Glenside Bike night, Lansdale Bike night and the Rockledge Car and Bike show. Its always fun to witness in the community and we hope to do more shows this coming year. There are many other Christian events that we serve at also.

Our passion is really getting into the secular Motorcycle Clubs and being a light that shines bright in their darkness, (Matt. 5:16 "In the same way let your light shine before others, that they may see your good deeds and glorify your father in Heaven.") By serving in many of their fund raising events, rides and anywhere they need us, we became a presence that they can't ignore. The Motorcycle Clubs in our area now know they can count on us.

We spent the last four months collecting clothing with the Mavericks MC for their Clothing for Veterans drive. When the drive was over, there was over 4000 pieces of clothing that got delivered to the Men and Woman Vet Centers in our area.

Because of this, we were volunteered to take part in the 5th annual Food for Families drive. No other MC or Christian Club has been invited to take part in this. We are the first. A HUGH honor to be asked to take part in a MCs event.

In the Food for Families drive our club with the help of some of the Calvary Riders handed out flyers for five Saturdays in October and November with Bikers Against Child Abuse and the Mavericks. Together we collected 240 turkeys and raised \$1400 dollars to give to local church food banks, the Veterans Center and some local needy families. In the time that we have served with these MCs we had one on one time to share our stories with their members. A chance to witness. How Cool is that!!! Again because of the effort of our T.E.A.M. we have been asked to serve on the committee for the Gold Star Mom Family Picnic.

We have also started a motorcycle Bible study that meets once a week. We are hoping to reach out to some of the guys we met that we know are looking for something different. We are even blessed to have a secular motorcyclist in attendance!

Words spoken are not just sounds and words written are not just letters bunched together, but words are an effective tool to communicate our thoughts and emotions. Of course, words may be expressed carelessly or without respect for the truth like gossip, which reminds me, Unless you know it's the truth, it could be a lie. The Book of Proverbs has some advice on our subject and here are several verses, 12:25, An anxious heart weighs a man down, but a kind word cheers him up. Then 25:11, A word aptly spoken, is like apples of gold in settings of silver. In the Book of James we are told that When we can control the tongue, we can control the rest of our lives; like a rudder of a ship, the tongue can direct our course. There are ways in which we can MAXIMIZE THE POWER OF WORDS. We can pray with the Psalmist that the words we verbalize and what we meditate upon will be pleasing to God. We can choose what we say and how we say it or to paraphrase the Golden Rule, Speak to others as you would want them to speak to you. 
