

## THE BIRTH OF JESUS

### LUKE 2:1-20 (NIV)

**2** In those days Caesar Augustus issued a decree that a census should be taken of the entire Roman world. **2** (This was the first census that took place while<sup>1a</sup> Quirinius was governor of Syria.) **3** And everyone went to their own town to register.

**4** So Joseph also went up from the town of Nazareth in Galilee to Judea, to Bethlehem the town of David, because he belonged to the house and line of David. **5** He went there to register with Mary, who was pledged to be married to him and was expecting a child. **6** While they were there, the time came for the baby to be born, **7** and she gave birth to her firstborn, a son. She wrapped him in cloths and placed him in a manger, because there was no guest room available for them.

**8** And there were shepherds living out in the fields nearby, keeping watch over their flocks at night. **9** An angel of the Lord appeared to them, and the glory of the Lord shone around them, and they were terrified. **10** But the angel said to them, “Do not be afraid. I bring you good news that will cause great joy for all the people. **11** Today in the town of David a Savior has been born to you; he is the Messiah, the Lord. **12** This will be a sign to you: You will find a baby wrapped in cloths and lying in a manger.”

<sup>13</sup> Suddenly a great company of the heavenly host appeared with the angel, praising God and saying,

<sup>14</sup> “Glory to God in the highest heaven, and on earth peace to those on whom his favor rests.”

<sup>15</sup> When the angels had left them and gone into heaven, the shepherds said to one another, “Let’s go to Bethlehem and see this thing that has happened, which the Lord has told us about.”

<sup>16</sup> So they hurried off and found Mary and Joseph, and the baby, who was lying in the manger. <sup>17</sup> When they had seen him, they spread the word concerning what had been told them about this child, <sup>18</sup> and all who heard it were amazed at what the shepherds said to them. <sup>19</sup> But Mary treasured up all these things and pondered them in her heart. <sup>20</sup> The shepherds returned, glorifying and praising God for all the things they had heard and seen, which were just as they had been told.

## REFLECTION

Here we are approaching another new year; a time when we look both forward and back. We look back fondly on good times, friends and family and if we’re smart to learn from our mistakes. We look forward (and some even make new year’s resolutions) on where we would like to be in this life and, if we are wise, where you wish to be in the next. Pastor Eddy touched on this today about how we look forward to different events in our lives; as children when we get older, as teenagers when we are adults, when we get married, when we retire, etc.

I have come to this conclusion in my life, I believe the most important planning on your future is not where you will be and what you will be here on earth but how you will fare when you pass from this life. If you check out the World Population clock you see there is a death every eleven seconds. You do not know when your time is up, so, your planning might be all in vain.

And (Jesus) told them a parable, saying, “The land of a rich man was very productive. And he began reasoning to himself, saying, “What shall I do, since I have no place to store my crops?” Then he said, “This is what I will do: I will tear down my barns and build larger ones, and there I will store all my grain and my goods. And I will say to my soul, “Soul, you have many goods laid up for many years to come; take your ease, eat, drink and be merry.” But God said to him, ‘You fool! This very night your soul is required of you; and now who will own what you have prepared?’ Luke 12:16-20 (NASB)

But, as believers, those who believe Jesus is who He said He was, have confessed our sins and have put our faith in Him, we already have a “foot in the door”. ## **WILL ROGERS**

The story is told of Will Rogers, the humorist, who on one occasion went in to get a passport. The official said, “We need to see your birth certificate.” Rogers replied, “What for?” The man behind the desk responded, “For proof of your birth.” Rogers looked at the man whimsically and said, “Well, I’m here, ain’t I?”

I am not sure if Will Rogers got his passport or not, but he does make a good point. Life is the best proof of birth. In his first letter, the Apostle John argues that a new life in Christ is the best proof of a new birth from Christ. While John wrote his Gospel to bring unbelievers to a settled faith in Christ, he wrote his primary epistle to give believers a sure footed confidence that they possessed eternal life (John 20:31; 1 John 5:13). He wants them to be saved without a doubt. To that end, he sets before them several indisputable birthmarks of a true follower of Christ.

Firstly, a true Christian believes what the Bible teaches about Jesus Christ (1 John 5:1). The Christian has a definite and biblically informed view of the person and work of Christ. They understand the basics about who Jesus is and what Jesus came to do. They recognize Him as the incarnate, sinless, and eternal Son of God. They understand Him to be the promised Messiah and understand that He put away sin by the sacrifice of Himself on the cross. They also believe that on the third day He conquered the grave.

Secondly, a true Christian eagerly lives in fellowship with other believers (1 John 1:6–7). The Christian will not be churchless (1 John 2:19). There will be a strong sense of belonging. Fellowship with God leads to fellowship with those who also are in fellowship with God and walk in the light. The Christian will live out their profession of faith in the context of the local church.

Thirdly, a true Christian has a deep awareness of sin (1 John 1:8–10). The Christian who walks in the light, as God dwells in light, knows that their heart is desperately wicked and a veritable factory of idols. Living under the glare of God’s holiness, the saint of God constantly seeks in confession the remedy of Christ’s blood for their falling short. Fundamentally, there is a new sensitivity to sin.

If you were arrested under suspicion of being a Christian, would there be enough evidence to convict you? Do you have these three birthmarks of genuine conversion? Is eternal life coursing through your life? Philip De Courcy Submitted by George Tamburino (NY)

- H. Holy Father, Blameless Son and Compassionately Loving Holy Spirit. Ephesians 1:4 He said He knew you before the beginning of time to be Holy, Blameless and Compassionately Loving. You may feel alone, but He is always with you everywhere you are every time.

- **Omnibenevolent:** God is all-good or without evil

Holy, Blameless and Compassionately Loving, He is not the one that brings you hurt or sadness as it is against His nature to do so.
