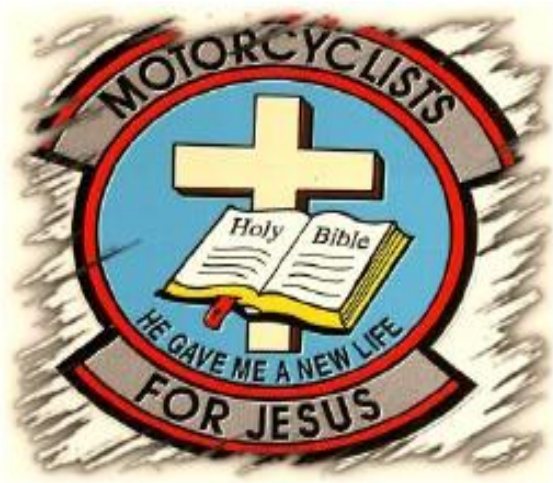

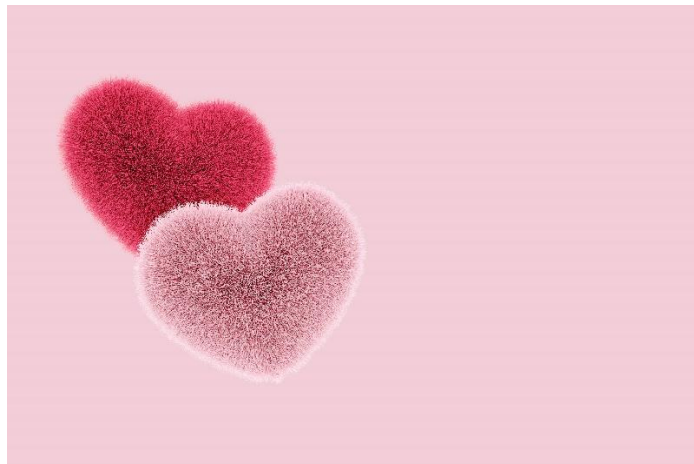
HAPPY VALENTINE'S DAY
