Hello from Ohio. We have had a really cold snap here in Ohio. It was a (-1) when I got up yesterday morning, with a high for the day of (12). Last week we had 10" of snow on Monday, and another 4" on Friday, which is still on the ground. Buuuurrr, not very conducive for motorcycle riding. It's suppose to moderate starting today with temps in the upper 20s. Unlike my son, who loves snow and cold weather for snowmobiling, I prefer warm weather.

Ministering to lost bikers is becoming a bigger challenge. The message has not changed, but the events we are taking the message to has become fewer and fewer. Our newer members have probably not noticed this decline of events. We used to have Three large M/C organizations. They had many local club (Like our TEAMS) which sponsored events we witnessed to. Today, that has been reduced to just one.

Honda introduced their GoldWing line of motorcycles in 1974. Shortly after, the Gold Wing Road Riders (GWRRA) was formed in 1977 by GoldWing Owners. Then, in 1987, just two years before MJM got started (1989), the Gold Wing Touring Association (GWT) got started. Both these organizations grew rapidly for a number of years. At their peak, the GWRRA was the largest MC organization in the US, after the AMA. It had 80,000 members with over 800 chapters. You could find a chapter/club from one of these two organizations in about ever town with a Honda Dealer. In 1983, Harley Davidson (factory) joined in and started the Harley's Owner Group (HOG). Today, HOG is the largest motorcycle organization in the world. They have over 1 million 200 thousand members in 1,400 chapters worldwide.

In the 90s and early 2000 you could find a number of motorcycle events or rallies from these three clubs within a 50 mile ride from home every weekend. It was like the individual local clubs were sort-of in competition with each other. They held many fantastic well organized rallies. I can remember having to pick and choose which event we wanted to go to. Some clubs even contacted our rally coordinator Earl Dudgeon in advance to schedule our MJM Evangelist for their Sunday service. As you know, that's not the case today. So, what happened?

Well, both Honda organizations have disbanded. Their membership interest began to change. The cost of doing business kept going up, while their membership kept going down . And, the lack of dealer and manufacturer support didn't help either. The GWRRA held on the longest. They closed their doors in 2022. The main reason given, "high operating cost". American Honda's response, "We hate to see them go, they were a asset to motorcycling". Did they? Sadly, no offer to help support all those GoldWing GWRRA buyers was ever made. However, the HOG organization, is alive and still going strong.

Today, MJM has the same problem. It's membership is faltering like those secular organizations. MJM needs more new members to spread the Word. I pray you are carrying some MJM information and Membership Apps on your bikes to share with Christian bikers as you ride. We do not want to have a repeat of what happened to those secular organizations. They existed only for their personal fun and pleasure. By them closing up shop, nothing was really lost other than some fun activities. However, MJM has a mission. Souls are at stake. Back in the nineties, MC events were so-to-speak just handed to us to attend. Today we have to hunt for them and they may not be next door. It may

cost a little more and we may have to ride a little further to attend them. Those reasons do not change MJMs mission or purpose to spread the gospel as Jesus directed us. The verse below say's it all:

Rom 10:13-14 The Lord God will save everyone who asks him for help.' 14 But people will never ask Christ to help them if they have not believed in him. And they will never believe in him if they have not heard about him. And they will not hear about him unless somebody tells God's message to them. 15 And nobody can go to tell God's message to people unless God sends them. (Easy English Version)


