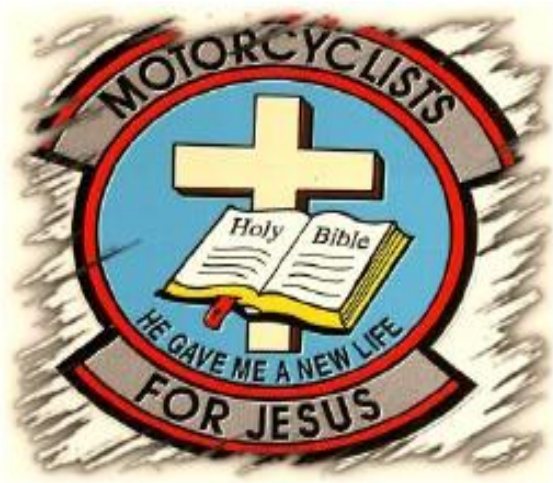

STORMS

Thomas Dorsey, a black preacher's son whose walk was back and forth with the Lord, back in 1932 faced a great storm in his life. We can but guess the thoughts that raced through his mind in the next weeks but after a time he sat down at a piano and created these lines to the hymn "Precious Lord, Take My Hand".

*Precious Lord, take my hand, lead me on, help me stand- I am tired, I am weak, I am worn;
Thro' the storm, thro' the night, lead me on to the light- Take my hand, precious Lord, lead me home.*

When my way grows drear, Precious Lord, linger near- when my life is almost gone. Hear my cry, hear my call, hold my hand lest I fall- Take my hand Precious Lord, lead me home.

The Lord did indeed take Thomas's hand and he went on to write more than 250 gospel songs. The Almighty could indeed erase your present troubles and I'm sure we all pray that He does so, who likes to go through "the valley"? Why He does with some and not with others we might never know till we can meet Jesus in the Here After. Some say troubles are trials, I believe some are and some are just things that happen in this fallen world.

Whichever the case our response should be to cling to the faith we have been called to. Our faith, our hope, our trust is in God alone. He alone knows what's best for us and will guide us to that end. Turbulent times and just for a time. Eternity is timeless.

Concerning God's view of Time—

Considering God's vs. our perspective on time I'm reminded of what C.S.Lewis wrote; (very deep stuff)

If you picture Time as a straight line along which we have to travel, then you must picture God as the whole page on which the line is drawn. We come to the parts of the line one by one; we have to leave A behind before we get to B, and cannot reach C until we leave B behind. God, from above or outside or all around, contains the whole line, and sees it all.

Another difficulty we get if we believe God to be in time is this. Everyone who believes in God at all believes that He knows what you and I are going to do tomorrow. But if He knows I am going to do so-and so, how can I be free to do otherwise?

Well, here once again, the difficulty comes from thinking that God is progressing along the time-line like us; the only difference being that He can see ahead and we cannot. Well, if that were true, if God foresaw our acts, it would be very hard to understand how we could be free not to do them. But suppose God is outside and above the time-line. In that case, what we call 'tomorrow' is visible to Him in just the same way as what we call 'today'. All the days are 'now' for Him.

He does not remember you doing things yesterday; He simply see you doing them: because, though tomorrow is not yet there for you, it is for Him. You never supposed that your actions at this moment were any less free because He knows what you are doing. Well, He knows your tomorrow's actions in just the same way-because He is already in tomorrow and can simply watch you. In a sense, He does not know your action till you have done it: but then the moment at which you have done it is already 'now' for Him. George Tamburino (NY)

EDITOR'S CORNER

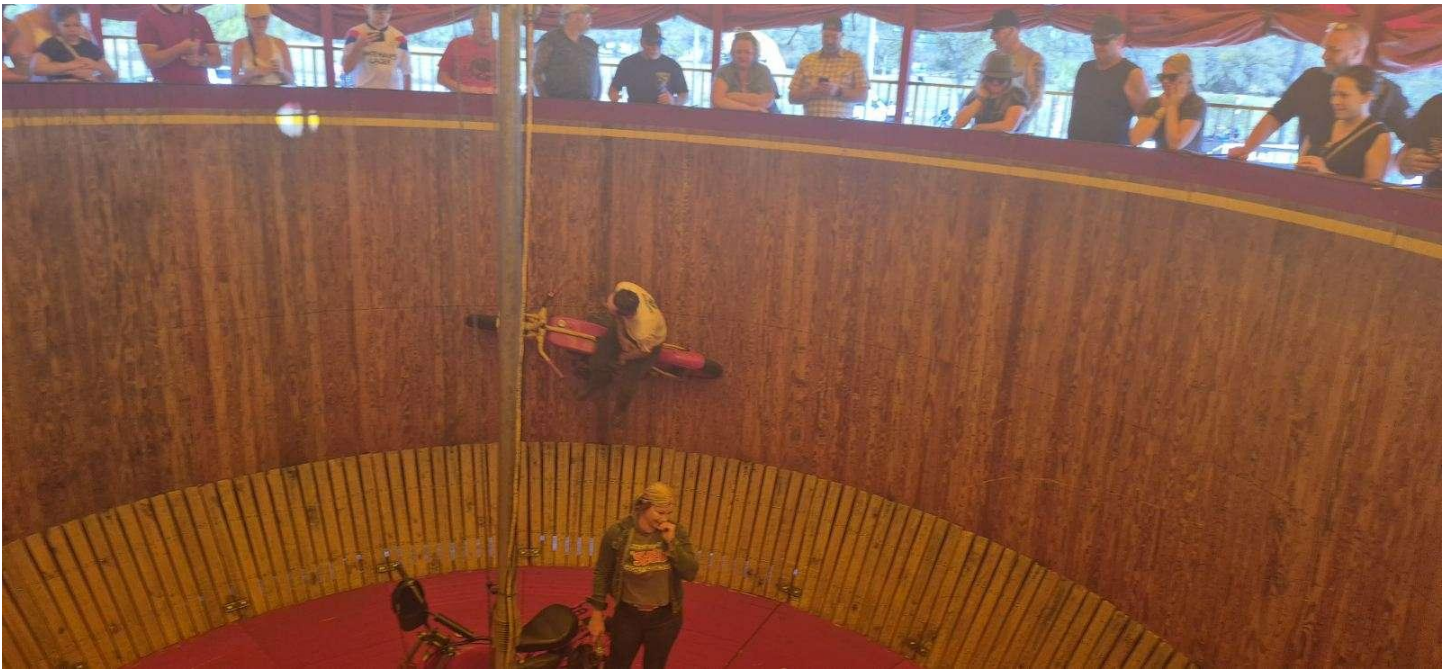
