# PUMPKIN PIE

## Ingredients

Original recipe (1X) yields 8 servings

- 1 (15-ounce) can pumpkin puree
- 1 (14-ounce) can Eagle Brand Sweetened Condensed Milk
- 2 large eggs
- 1 teaspoon ground cinnamon
- 1/2 teaspoon ground ginger
- 1/2 teaspoon ground nutmeg
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 1 (9-inch) unbaked pie crust

## Instructions

Gather all ingredients and preheat the oven to 425 degrees F (220 degrees C).

Whisk pumpkin puree, condensed milk, eggs, cinnamon, ginger, nutmeg, and salt together in a medium bowl until smooth.


Pour into crust. Bake in the preheated oven for 15 minutes.

Reduce oven temperature to 350 degrees F (175 degrees C) and continue baking until a knife inserted 1 inch from the crust comes out clean, 35 to 40 minutes. Let cool before serving.

The Board of Directors shall then approve, or disapprove the nomination. Nominations will be considered with regard to geographical location. If approved by the Board, ballots for the nominee(s) shall be mailed individually to each member to approve their choice of nominees.


