Elected Directors may serve for two (2) consecutive four (4) year terms. However, they must be elected by the membership for each of those terms. Directors may appoint a member to fill a Board position vacated either by a Director's not meeting attendance requirements, resignation, or death. The appointee will hold office until the next election of the Board of Directors. Completing a vacated term doesn't count as the first of two (2) consecutive terms. Decisions of the Board will be determined by a simple majority vote.

Nominations will be considered with regard to geographical location. No more than two from any state will be permitted to be on the Board of Directors at same time.

The Board of Directors shall consist of at least four (4) elected members, but not more than seven (7) plus the Chaplain/Educational Director. The Chaplain/Educational Director will be an ex-officio member of the Board. He or she will also be involved in the administrative functions of the Ministry. A Chairperson of the Board will be elected annually by the Board of Directors. The Chairperson of the Board may vote and make motions.


