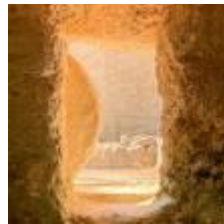

IT'S JUST A FEELLING, TRUE OR NOT, IT'LL CHANGE

You have heard that it was said, 'You shall love your neighbor and hate your enemy.' 44 But I say to you, Love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you, 45 so that you may be sons of your Father who is in heaven. For he makes his sun rise on the evil and on the good and sends rain on the just and on the unjust. 46 For if you love those who love you, what reward do you have? Do not even the tax collectors do the same? 47 And if you greet only your brothers, what more are you doing than others? Do not even the Gentiles do the same? 48 You therefore must be perfect, as your heavenly Father is perfect. Matthew 5:43-48

By telling us not to retaliate, Jesus keeps us from taking the law into our own hands. By loving and praying for our enemies, we can overcome can overcome evil with good.

The Pharisees interpreted Leviticus 19:18 as teaching that they should love only those who love in return, and Psalms 139:19-22 and 140:9-11 as meaning that they should hate their enemies. But

Jesus says we are to love our enemies. If you love your enemies and treat them well, you will truly show that Jesus is Lord of your life. This is possible only for those who give themselves fully to God, because only he can deliver people from natural selfishness. We must trust the Holy Spirit to help us show love to those for whom we may not feel love.

How can we be perfect? (1) In character: In this life we cannot be flawless, but we can aspire to be as much like Christ as possible. (2) In holiness: Like the Pharisees, we are to separate ourselves from the world's sinful values. But unlike the Pharisees, we are to be devoted to God's desires rather than our own and carry his love and mercy into the world. (3) In maturity: We can't achieve Christlike character and holy living all at once, but we must grow toward maturity and wholeness. Just as we expect different behavior from a baby, a child, a teenager, and an adult, so God expects different behavior from us, depending on our stage of spiritual development. (4) In love: We can seek to love others as completely as God loves us.

We can be perfect if our behavior is appropriate for our maturity level — perfect, yet with much room to grow. Our tendency to sin must never deter us from striving to be more like Christ. Christ calls all of his disciples to excel, to rise above mediocrity, and to mature in every area, becoming like him. Those who strive to become perfect will one day be perfect, even as Christ is perfect (1 John 3:2-3).

DO NOT JUDGE OTHERS LUKE 6:30-38

30 Give to anyone who asks; and when things are taken away from you, don't try to get them back. 31 Do to others as you would like them to do to you. 32 If you love only those who love you, why should you get credit for that? Even sinners love those who love them! 33 And if you do good only to those who do good to you, why should you get credit? Even sinners do that much! 34 And if you lend money only to those who can repay you, why should you get credit? Even sinners will lend to other sinners for a full return.

35 Love your enemies! Do good to them. Lend to them without expecting to be repaid. Then your reward from heaven will be very great, and you will truly be acting as children of the Most High, for he is kind to those who are unthankful and wicked. 36 You must be compassionate, just as your Father is compassionate. 37 "Do not judge others, and you will not be judged. Do not condemn others, or it will all come back against you. Forgive others, and you will be forgiven. 38 Give, and you will receive. Your gift will return to you fully pressed down, shaken together to make room for more, running over, and poured into your lap. The amount you give will determine the amount you get back."

Love means action. One way to put love to work is to take the initiative in meeting specific needs. This is easy to do with people who love us, people whom we trust; but love means doing this even to those who dislike us or hurt us. The money we give others should be a gift, not a high-interest loan that will put a burden on them. Give as though you are giving to God.

A forgiving spirit demonstrates that a person has received God's forgiveness. Jesus uses the picture of measuring grain in a basket to ensure the full amount. If we are critical rather than compassionate, we will also receive criticism. If we treat others generously, graciously, and compassionately, however, these qualities will come back to us in full measure. We are to love others, not judge them.

16 For this is how God loved the world: He gave his one and only Son, so that everyone who believes in him will not perish but have eternal life. 17 God sent his Son into the world not to judge the world, but to save the world through him. John 3:16-17

Not to judge, condemn, persecute, damnation, picking or putting down anyone.

This means even in "self-righteous" situations as we can see He did not do in this Holy Week leading to Resurrection Sunday.

When I arrived at Vern's on Tuesday morning, he had his trailer hooked up to get furniture for a family that had lost everything in a fire the night before. We ended up making three trips picking up beds, tv, couches, tables, microwaves, etc. for the family. The third trip was for more beds that were not needed, But next morning, another family was burned out of their home.

When we did get to Daytona, Vern had paid to have his motorhome to be winterized, but they had not. When we turned on the water it broke numerous parts in the home and damaged electrical components also. So, we had troubles with repair vendors (Never fixed) and ended up with a rolling cave.

There were a record number of vendors set up at Cacklebery's this year and record numbers of bikers to show up at the races. But it was also the record lowest spending at Bike Week. Some vendors doing less than a third of last year and lower than Covid years. Many were lucky to break even. We prayed with many vendors. Sorry to say, many said that they would not return next year.

We had a new vendor set up next to us this year who is fighting Cancer. She is diagnosed terminal, and all treatment has been stopped on her to let her see her last days. We became close to her. Many of our messages impacted her.

Some of the morning message, but more the loving care and fellowship we had with her in helping her set up. With fire marshal, electricity, computer printouts, and loving our neighbor like ourselves.

One day, the Fire Marshal came around just a few hours before the event was going to start with the director of the campgrounds. He said we needed to have a commercial fire extinguisher. The director said we knew the rules and should have had one. Nobody on the campgrounds had any except the food vendors. Some got upset because he lied. But we knew he was lost and was trying to look good in front of the Fire Marshall. What a run-on Home Depot, Lowes, and Walmart. It does not matter what others do, but what we do, "Forgive them for they know not what they do."

We were allowed to minister to many who came by who worked there, other vendors and He ministered to us greatly because you can't outgive God.

We are there to do God's Ministry, be CHRIST-like, not Santo-like, do His will, not mine, not any political party, bike brand, creed, option, custom, taut, experienced, denomination, board approved or opinion. Does not matter what I think, all that matters is what He says in the Word of God. The whole Word of God. IT is TRUTH from Gen 1:1-Rev22:21 or not. If God said it, He Means it. The Old Testament is The New Testament foretold and the New Testament Is the Old Testament Fulfilled.

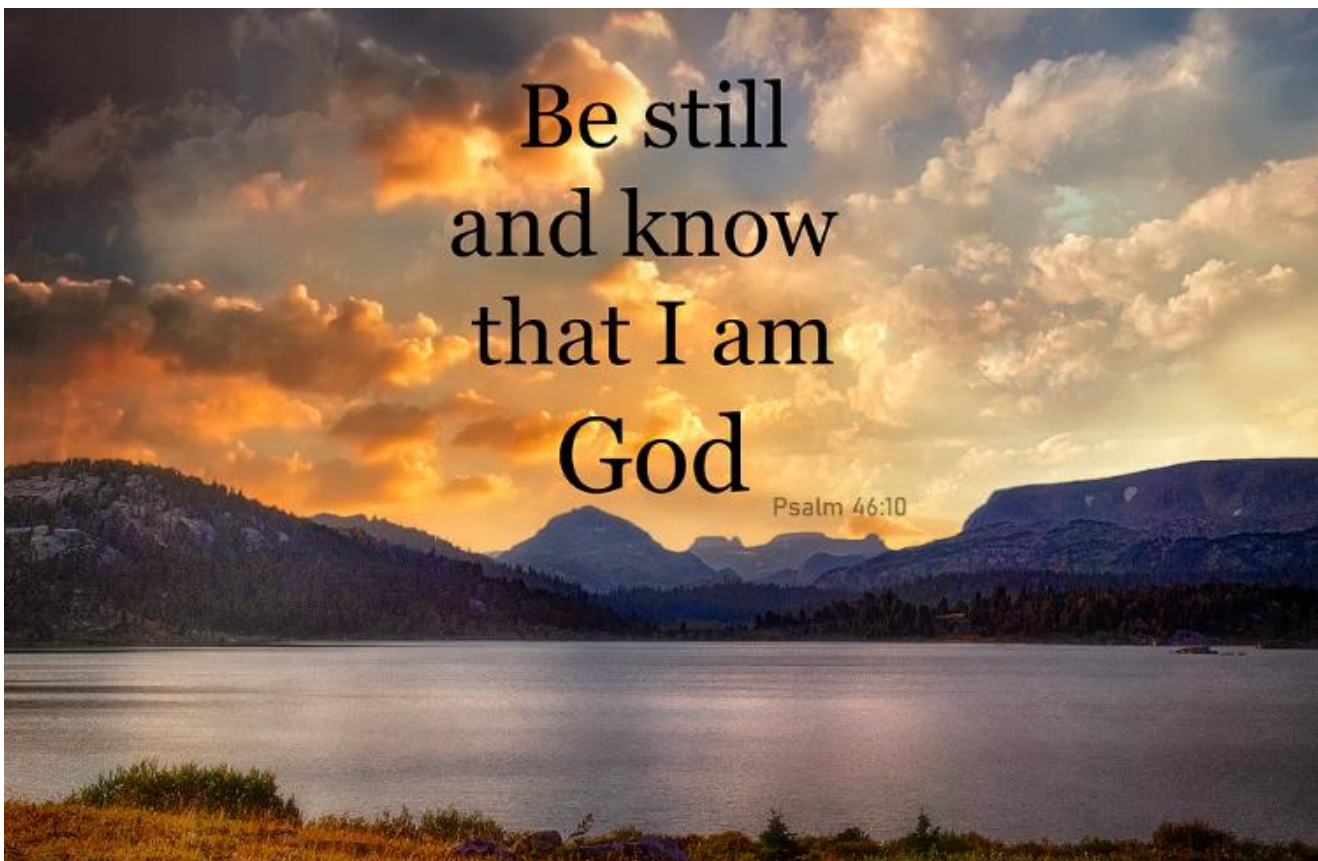

He beat death. So many times in our lives we are told there’s nothing further that can be done, just quit, that is impossible. My Bible says “And God is able to bless you abundantly, so that in all things at all times, having all that you need, you will abound in every good work.” 2 Corinthians 9:8 NIV In 2017 my mom went into the hospital on January 6 and they immediately had to put a tracheostomy in her throat to breathe. A few months later she pulled the trach out. She died for 20 minutes but they brought her back. The doctor told me in his professional opinion she probably suffered brain damage and due to her kidney disease and age did I really want to put her through dialysis. My response was, that is my mother and start the dialysis and give her a chance. There was no brain damage and she was definitely herself. Due to they could not remove the tracheostomy she was not able to speak. They tried a speaking valve but it did not work. She was told she would never talk. God had other plans and a few months later she miraculously started speaking. Another thing to note is that my mother started stuttering in her since teenage years. In her adult years God healed her of stuttering. Satan had tried to steal my mother’s voice twice. God had other plans. My mother spoke quite well until her passing January 26, 2018. During that last year of her life she was able to reunite with her brother. They had not spoken for 7 years. Had we just given up and accepted the doctor’s word these miracles would not have happened. God is the same yesterday, today, and tomorrow.
