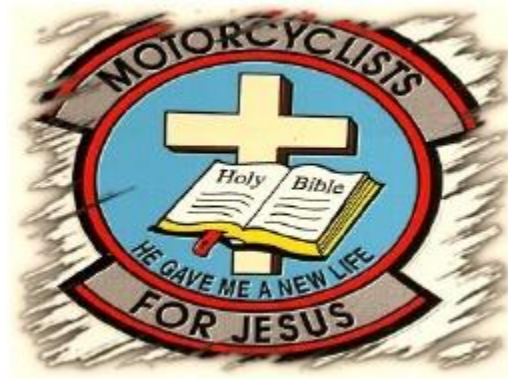


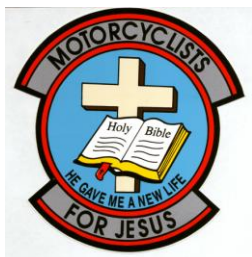

A Trying Six Months

I started with flu like symptoms. Went to the doctor and all he did was give me antibiotics and steroids. This went on from December 28 till mid February. My wife and I were very frustrated with the doctor. We asked to have testing done and he refused. So I talked with my rheumatologist he gave me a script to have a Ct-scan done of the chest, because I was short of breath.

March 2, I had the Ct-scan done. It showed a mass above the stomach. I also had a pulmonary function test done as well. That came back negative. I became anemic and was put on iron to help this situation. Next I had a Ct-scan with contrast. That proved that there was a mass right at the top of the stomach and base of the esophagus. I was advised to have a colonoscopy and endoscopy.

Those tests were scheduled for April 7, both at the same time. The doctor told my wife and I whether it is cancerous or not it had to come out. She put a rush on the biopsy. The next day, April 8, was our 43rd wedding anniversary. The phone rang around 1:30pm; it was the doctor with the report that the mass is malignant. I am so glad that we celebrated our anniversary on Saturday prior, at Red Lobster.

Next we met with the oncologist. She ordered a PET scan. They found out all the particulars about the mass. It measured 2cm across. I was advised to go to Fox Chase Cancer Center for treatment. The surgeon explained the surgery to us. He said it could take 8-10 hours. After meeting with the surgeon I started a regimen of chemo and radiation. I also had a stomach tube put in along with a port for the chemo.

Needless to say this really affected the whole family. We were fortunate to have many motorcycle friends, family, church family, and others who formed an army of prayer warriors. I made it through the treatments with NO serious side effects. The only thing I experienced was a lot of burping and hiccups. I am certain that God had his hand on me the whole time!!!

I wound up with a blood clot in a lung, in July. So they put a filter in my groin area on August 11, to stop or break up any more blood clots. The cancer surgery was done on August 13. Biopsies were performed on surrounding tissues and found clean!!!! So I am cancer free!!!!!!!! PTL!!!!!!!! The surgeon said he saw something on one of my kidneys that needs to be addressed as a precaution. I was discharged on August 25.

Glad to be home!!!! Progress was being made as far as recovery. I became depressed and frustrated with the recovery. I thought it would be quicker than it was. I felt like I was playing "Russian Roulette" one day I would eat something no problem. Two or three days later the same thing would make me sick. I have to confess that I fell away from devotions and prayer. I got to the point where I wasn't sleeping. Usually just 2-3 hours per night.

So on October 13 we went to see my psychiatrist. On the morning of October 14 I fell at the foot of our bed at 5am. My wife immediately said about going to the hospital. Like most men I said, "No, just help me get up." She then called my oldest son. He was away on business. He called the future daughter-in-law and she convinced me to go to the hospital. Lori had called the ambulance. We were in the ER Department till around 4pm. I don't remember going to a room just waking up October 24. That's 10 days I can't account for.

Since my surgery we decided we needed Advanced Directives. They were in the works but not finalized and signed!!! The doctors put me on the vent to save my life. That decision is the only reason I can write this testimony. Because otherwise I would be dead!!! Is GOD in control or what??? So because of a loving GOD and my wife, I have been given a second chance to work for HIM!! That is exactly why I am sharing this testimony of GOD's healing, love, forgiveness, and power with you!!!

For the next 10 days I laid there in the hospital in a medically induced coma. I can only imagine what my family and friends were going through!!! Someone said, "They didn't know how they should pray; for my healing or pray for my release to heaven!!! During those 10 days our GOD sustained my family and me!!! The doctors were busy doing tests. Some communicated well with the family others did not. They attempted a spinal tap, a few days on the vent, and emergency dialysis. I was toxic from lithium.

So many people told me it wasn't pretty. To this day no doctor has given us a diagnosis!! So much for

professionals!! I guess that is why they call their clientele “practices”. I have to tell you that we were in the process of getting advanced directives drafted. My wish for a number of years has been not to put the plug in, thereby saving the family the agony of pulling the plug!! However according to HIPPA since the paper work was not in place the decision was made to use the ventilator. I am able to write this testimony because of that decision. Is GOD in control or what??? So because of a loving GOD and my wife I have been given a second chance to work for HIM!!

From the hospital I went for therapy to the same care facility that my parents where in before they passed. Some of the folks that took care of them are still there. So I had a reunion of sorts. Not without some issues. Doctors at the hospital changed my medications around. The first day at the “manor” I noticed my legs were swollen from the knee to the ankle. Nothing was done even after I repeatedly told the nurses and they saw the problem. Finally, after the third or fourth day I threatened to call a lawyer and Social Security if I did not get the right meds and see a doctor till the next day by 10am. Amazingly the doctor came in that evening and was in total agreement with my getting the right meds. Two days later no more swelling of the legs!!!

While at the “manor” I snapped at numerous people. I recognized my bad behavior and apologized to each and every one of them. From then on my care was very good. Therapy was excellent!!! I progressed at a fast pace. I was discharged on November 11, Veteran’s Day.

At home now!!! I have a home health care nurse once a week, PT twice a week, and OPT twice a week. I have been put on Warfarin (comidin) because of a blood clot prior to my surgery. So my life has been filled with all kinds of appointments since my release from the “manor”. Not too many days where I am not required to do something or be somewhere relative to this latest hospital stay as well as the surgery post ops. Most recently I had a piece of shrimp stuck in my Adam’s apple area (ER trip), and Tuesday November 24 for an endoscopy and have the esophagus stretched at Fox Chase Cancer Center. This was done so I could swallow easier!!

Through it ALL I’ve learned to trust in JESUS I’ve learned to trust in GOD!!! The Bible says, “HE will never leave you or forsake you”!!! I think I understand that very well now!!! It is obvious to me that HE has a plan and a purpose for my life. Early on in my fight against cancer an army of Prayer Warriors were assembled. Those prayers have brought me to this point!!! The doctors are just HIS instruments like you and I!!!

In conclusion let me share something with you that happened the Sunday before I was released from the “manor”. The family was exhausted to say the least!!! So I suggested we go out for lunch. We went to TGI Fridays. Upon our return to the “manor”, we were just talking, and Lori, our future daughter-in-law said, “Hey Pop what is this about the “Big House”. I said, ‘What do you mean. I have no idea!’ She repeated, “What is this about the Big House and lots of food.” I said, “The only thing I think about as far as the “Big House” is jail.” Then like lightning it hit me!!! The words to a song from a VBS lesson, “It’s a big big house with lots and lots of rooms. It’s a big, big house with lots and lots of food.”!!! I hope you KNOW that this comes directly from the Bible. John 14:1 and 2 reads, “Do not let your hearts be troubled. Trust in God; trust also in me. In my Father’s house are many rooms; if it were not so would I have told you. I am going there to prepare a place for you!!! (NIV) That YOU, includes YOU and me no matter where we have been or what we have done HE (GOD) loves us!!! What creator doesn’t love his creation!!!

In closing let me say THANK YOU TO ALL my Prayer Warriors, and especially my wife and the rest of my family and friends!!! Without whom I would not have been able to write this testimony!!! I hope you are blessed because I shared a small portion of what I have called “A Trying Six Months!!! After thinking about this it was a very trying year!!! However, GOD has been so faithful to me it is hard to comprehend HIS GREAT LOVE!!! On behalf of my faithful family and friends THANK YOU again for all the prayers, through it all!!!!!!!

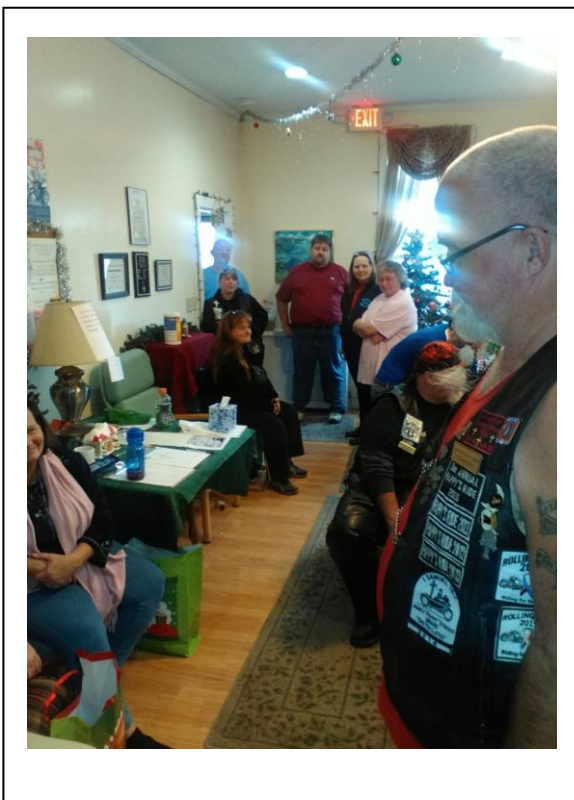

Reaching Out

This past week MJM Rolling Saints did something a little different for the Christmas season. We Solicited donations and also purchased some items for a Homeless Center in Gettysburg. Some of our members asked for basic donations such as men's, women's and children's socks which the homeless said were most needed. We received over 1200 new pairs of all types of socks for men, women and children! We asked for toothbrushes and toothpaste donations from local dentists in the adjacent town of Hanover. We received hundreds of toothbrushes and toothpaste! This is awesome. When we work for the Lord, things just seem to happen and fall into place and greatly exceed our expectations. Can I get an AMEN!!!! We also supplied and installed a much needed microwave at the center. We also put together and delivered Christmas packages for all 30 individuals at the homeless center and spent some time with the homeless there. Gettysburg C.A.R.E.S. (which stands for Combined Area Resource Center) provides shelter for those in need when no other shelters are available in the Gettysburg area. The Ministry is an independent, non-profit 501C3 Corporation which is in partnership with 14 local churches. Its contributions are from local churches and community organizations. No funding is provided by State, Local or Federal government organizations. Each one of the local 14 churches opens their doors every night to host the homeless overnight for a two week period. This effort is coordinated by C.A.R.E.S during the October - April timeframe. Host volunteers are from the church congregations as well as C.A.R.E.S volunteers. C.A.R.E.S has a Resource Center in town which helps the homeless find jobs, medical assistance and eventually housing. The center is operational 7 days a week during the Church rotation period and 3 days a week during the warmer months. The center is available to the homeless during daytime hours. C.A.R.E.S. works with the Gettysburg Soup Kitchen nearby which provides a hearty Breakfast and Lunch for the homeless. The Resource Center offers the homeless the opportunity to microwave quick light meals before heading to the churches in the evening hours, and offers the homeless the opportunity to shower, wash do laundry, browse the computer for jobs and email friends and relatives. The center also provides an address so the homeless can receive mail, disability, Social Security benefits etc. The C.A.R.E.S program can provide assistance to a maximum of 30 individuals at any one (night) point in time.

MJM Rolling Saints is an established Ministry with a solid and dedicated amount of members who primarily focus on Motorcycle Ministry. In addition, we have a great relationship with other Motorcycle Clubs in the area. Many of these can and will help contribute to worthwhile causes when we plan them. Considering this Blessing, we are positioned and presented the opportunity to extend our Blessings and Christ's love to various people in need both physically and mentally wherever the Lord leads us! This type of reaching out could grow to helping the needy more often throughout the year as well as to anywhere we can do God's work.

Rolling Saints could eventually expand Outreach programs to visiting prisons, nursing homes and wherever led to love our neighbors and reach the lost while continuing to be a solid Motorcycle Ministry. The Bible has many references to feeding and clothing the poor. One of which is Matthew 25:35 (NIV) "For I was Hungry and you gave me something to eat, I was thirsty and you gave me something to drink, I was a stranger and you invited me in. I needed clothes and you clothed me..." Jesus Christ's Ministry centered on loving God and loving our neighbors as ourselves. In addition, there are many Biblical references regarding not just hearing the Word - but doing the Word. This opportunity gives a Rolling Saints member a chance to serve and hence to do the Word to whatever level he or she is led.

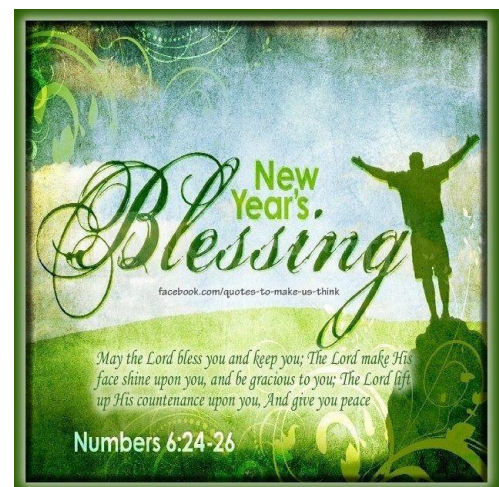
