Greater Love Hath No Man Than This

The ship the Dorchester in early 1943 was part of a convoy of three transport ships carrying troops to an American base in Greenland. On the morning of February 3rd, a German U boat sent 3 torpedoes towards it. One hit its mark well below the water line and the ship began to sink.

The captain gave the abandoned ship orders and it only took 20 minutes of being struck for the ship to slip beneath the black and icy waters. The impact of the torpedo not only killed scores and wounded many more but knocked out power. The soldiers below deck now scrambled in complete darkness with frigid water pouring in upon them, completely disoriented. In the midst of the chaos 4 voices brought calm and clarity, the voices of chaplains George Fox, a Methodist, Alexander Goode who was Jewish, John Washington, a Catholic, and Clark Poling Dutch Reformed.

The four moved among the soldiers tending the wounded, praying for the dying, encouraging the frightened, and guiding the bewildered and disoriented to safety. One survivor testified 'their voices were the only thing that kept me going'. The chaplains tried to maintain order topside handing out life jackets to the soldiers emerging from below deck. When they finally ran out of life vests four young soldiers were still without one, so the chaplains took off their own

vests and gave them to the four. One survivor who witnessed this testified it was the finest thing I have ever seen or hope to see this side of heaven. As the Dorchester finally sank beneath the icy Arctic waters survivors in the lifeboats testified that the final sight of the ship was the four chaplains standing together on the slanting submerging deck; a Jew, a Methodist, a Catholic, and a Dutch Reformed, their arms locked together and their voices were raised in prayer as the ship forever slipped beneath the freezing waters.

President Harry Truman said in part while dedicating a shrine to their memory at Temple University in Philadelphia; "Those four chaplains actually carried out the moral code which we are all supposed to live by. They obeyed the divine commandment that men should love one another. They really lived to the moral standard that declares, greater love hath no man than this; that a man lay down his life for his friends. They were not afraid of death because they knew that the word of God is stronger than death. Their belief, their faith, and His word enabled them to conquer death".

In 1960 Congress created a unique medal to honor the four, the Distinguished Service Cross and Purple Heart. In 1961 it was awarded to the surviving families of the four chaplains, the only time this medal ever was or will be awarded. (From The Founders Bible)

My grandfather was an Army WWII veteran that served in Germany. He was there for me from the day I was born until he passed in 1992. All the children, grandchildren, and great grandchildren called him 'Pops. He was not our 'blood' grandpa. 'Pops' and my grandmother got married when my mother was in high school. He was the only grandfather I ever knew. Rather I was happy or sad he was there. His love for me was limitless. He wiped my tears, laughed with me, and loved me. He did the same for my son, David. He was a plumber by trade and loved to cook and garden with my grandmother. They would go out to Amish country all the time and buy meat, cheese, and eggs. They became friends with a lot of Amish people. When I was little they took me with them. I always felt protected with them. When 'Pops' died my heart broke. It was the first big loss I experienced as an adult. It felt like my world collapsed. I did not cry at first because I felt I had to be strong for my grandmother. She said 'Pops' was the love of her life. We made the funeral arrangements and held the viewing and service. There were 7 grandchildren and all of them were there. 'Pops' used to give me 50 cent pieces and silver dollars. As I write this tears are starting to flow all these years later. God gave me 'Pops' because he knew I would need him throughout my life. He knows what we will need and who we will need.

Jeremiah 29:11 (NIV) "For I know the plans I have for you," declares the Lord, "plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future." I had hope and a future with 'Pops'.
