In the spring of 1949, Odria imposed political death sentences. My father Walter went underground with the Nation Democratic Front. They arranged to smuggle him out of Peru to the United States of America for political asylum.

This man had four PhD's, spoke six languages fluently, Ran the strongest military in South America, the SA Franchise for National Cash Register, an Olympian, Had a house one city block long and wide – three stories high with 32 paid servants. But he didn't speak English.

When he arrived to the Great United States of America and saw the statue of liberty and then docked in New York. He went to Ellis Island just like everyone else. He had a brother in the Pan American Union in Washington, DC. He was a political Leader. A man that was from wealth and prestige.
