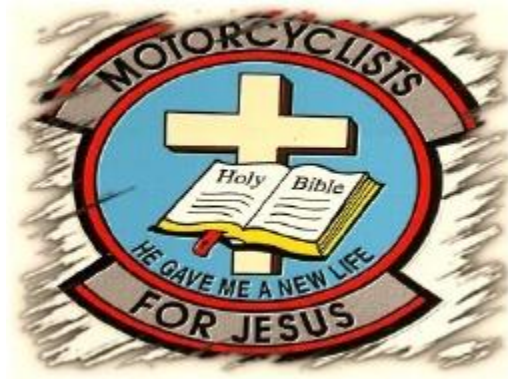

The Value of the TEAM Voice



We got our January TEAM Voice yesterday. Since Kerma and I retired from active MJM service two years ago, the Voice is now the only link we have with MJM. I used to contribute articles to the Voice on a regular basis. I realized I had not contributed anything to the Voice for a long time. As Charter/Life Time members, next month (March) will mark our 27th year with MJM. I have had the honor and privilege to wear many hats during those years, one of those hats being the Voice Editor for one year (Jan 2001-Jan 2002). Here is one area of importance most people don't ever think about as they read their monthly newsletter.

When I was asked by the board in 2007 to create an MJM Historical Record Document, I realized that past TEAM Voices might be a valuable resource to obtain some of MJM's historical information from. I had retained some past issues but was missing many. I put out a request in the Voice for any members who had any old Voice issues to please send them to me. The membership responded. Over the next few weeks, as the old Voices started coming in, I began developing an "Archive" of Voice Newsletters. And, I was right, these past issues became a valuable tool in helping me put together a time line of MJM's History. Just one example. When compiling the time frame and list of our officers and TEAMS they contained invaluable information. Who was our BOD Chairman and board members and when they served. When a TEAM first got started. I found a wealth of historical information as I went through those old Voices. I found they also contained a lot of history about the newsletter itself. Here is some newsletter history I found. The very first newsletter (Vol. 1, No. 1) had 6 pages and was published in March 1989, which just happened to be the month Kerma and I joined MJM after leaving the CMA two months earlier. During the first year, issues were published by founders Ralph & Joan Philpott, from 1990 through summer 1993 by founders Don & Fran Cheser. Faith Hammock became our first editor from the general membership the summer of 1993. From 1991-93 due to financial issues, the Voice was only printed every 3 months (4 times a year). During the non-print months, one of the directors would send out a one/two page update every month to the members. This update was primarily for getting to the membership dates and registration information/forms for upcoming events and rallies. Unlike today, back then there were two or three weekend rallies about every weekend which MJM members were encouraged to attend. Like many members, we went to them as we could afford to, which was usually two a month. It wasn't until 1995 MJM went back to having a monthly Voice. I believe these following Voice figures/numbers are pretty accurate? MJM has had 18 that I know of and possibly 19 editors since the first issue in 1989. This count also includes fill-in editors in between a full time editor. For example, Joan Philpott not only served as our first full time editor, she also served as a fill-in editor three different times until a full time editor could be found. This last January 2016 Voice was the 285th issue of the monthly MJM TEAM Voice. In 2004, there were also special printings done just for MJM booth handouts. It was well received by secular bikers and reprinted for a number of years. There were also those 24 Director updates which I made reference to earlier. We currently have 236 issues (82%) of the total Voices printed and 12 (50%) of the Director Updates in the Voice Archives. We are missing 49 issues. Since I searched diligently for them in 2007, I doubt very much those missing 49 will ever be located. However, if you happen to have or come across any old issues let me know. They just might be one of those 49 we need. When we get our newsletter whether it's a hard copy or e-mail we read it and usually just discard/delete it never thinking of it's potential historical value. We owe a big vote of thanks to all our past and our current editor for their service and dedication to this very important job. As you know, MJM is in need of a Voice Editor. Prayerfully consider taking on this very important job. In so doing, you will not only be supplying members with monthly information, you will also be helping to prolong MJM's history.

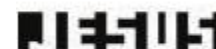
