Unbridled Worship Equated to Power in the Blood

Kim Walker Smith singing “Jesus Paid It All” (<https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=Ymkl0t0FOcw>) compelled me to share some thoughts on following Jesus. My goal is to praise with unbridled worship and receive the anointing of the Holy Spirit, thereby encouraging my church (and your) members to come together more often to sing praise to Jesus and Father releasing the Holy Spirit (within our hearts) power, guidance and wisdom. We will realize and accept our citizenship in the Kingdom Of God that Jesus proclaimed to bring to earth. As we unite in one voice we become the body of Christ able to forgive, rebuke, teach and learn in unconditional love under God’s Word and Will. How can we not have unbridled worship for the one and only God to claim He was willing to wash our sin away by the blood of His suffering in Jesus when He came to save us (His loved people – yes, everyone!).

Watching Kim sing “Jesus Paid It All” is leading worship by her throwing it all out on the line. She is pouring her heart out to Jesus. Not to an audience or trying to sound good. Whether Jesus touches her heart or she senses on a deeper level of intimacy, her lips tighten and we hear a beautiful quiver of connecting with the Almighty. When Kim feels the outpouring of the Holy Spirit in her heart she transcends to the joy of Jesus “has” paid it All. Her voice sounds off her revelation and brings the worship to a crescendo. She continues the outpour of worship and gratefulness as the body comes together in one excited accord. Unity. Worship the Almighty. Thanksgiving. Revelation. The Holy Spirit manifests itself as we let go and let God. His Will is done. But there is more work and souls to be saved. The Holy Spirit in hearts opened has revealed God’s love and power of forgiveness. As Kim drops back down from unbridled worship The Holy Spirit imparts reassurance of comfort, peace and joy. Both in Kim’s soft firm acknowledging singing to Jesus and the Holy Spirit presence settling into each open heart. This is the real deal.

Unbridled worship can be a prayer to God, which also brings on the Holy Spirit as God’s Helper. For example, my situation was to share the Good News by caroling to the parking lot of people scurrying here to there. How awkward would I sound by myself and what if? That’s when I made a decision to worship God. My worship was between my God and me. The key to great unbridled worship is picking a song with the words that tell the story on your heart which was placed there by the Holy Spirit. “Oh Come All Ye Faithful” does it for me. So as I had unbridled worship praising and singing to God and the parking lot audience became secondary. The power of the Holy Spirit filled me with joy, reassurance, peace and sustained me before I finished the first verse. I have been blessed similarly many times. All praise and glory be to God. You’ve watched and now it’s your turn.

To encourage some who have weighed out that God’s grace has already sufficed and are content to climb in thru the open window and watch from afar. The window of opportunity is about to close. When it closes upon the Second Coming of Jesus, those not in the house will be locked out. They will be carried away. The temptations from the Prince of Darkness are temporal and are meant to separate God’s people. Ask God why He died to atone for the sin of the world He created. “... do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, so that you may prove what the will of God is, that which is good and acceptable and perfect.” Romans 12:2. You won’t be able to take it with you and we can’t escape the tide of destruction looming on the horizon, but Jesus brought a refuge for His people. The Kingdom of God is near and the keys to the door are in His promise and Word. As we “... seek first His kingdom and His righteousness, and all these things will be added to you” Mat 6:33. Acceptance of Jesus and following Him brings the love of God and the power of His Holy Spirit into our hearts.
