Discovering your Cave of Gold

I like to sleep in on Sundays but lately the 9AM Disciple Making Workshop was waking me up way before my cheese and coffee time. Last week the group was getting so excited, I wandered out hoping to catch a cup of the brew that got them so charged up. There was no bottomless cup of strong coffee to be found. Then, I heard “Thanks” being given for living bread with meat...forget about the coffee-let's find the meat sandwiches! (“I am the living bread that came down out of heaven; if anyone eats of this bread, he will live forever; and the bread also which I will give for the life of the world is My flesh.” John 6:51). Drat! Double drat!... not a crumb to be found. After all that scurrying around looking for the goodies, I needed to rest in my corner. I became aware that their excitement came from sharing personal “discoveries” in the “living bread” which was their code for the Word of God that Jesus taught to his followers. I think they called it “living bread” because they were always moving it so the likens of me would not find it. But being woken up early and my appetite for bread I hung around to discover that man unlike mouse does not live by bread alone. By eavesdropping, I can tell you all about it. But, one really needs to sit in on the study to see the dynamics of the Holy Spirit moving from one member to another. Personal “discoveries” are being shared that moves the group to, yet, a deeper understanding of the scripture. It becomes a personal experience and a group discovery. The excitement grows as the Holy Spirit brings the group into a deeper discovery and understanding of the scripture which was achieved by the Holy Spirit moving among the individual members. With my small mouse brain vocabulary, I would have a hard time to relay the experience of the Holy Spirit moving thru the morning class. However, if you were looking at a picture of a marvelous waterfall-the Holy Spirits' presence would enable one to imagine the spray, the rainbow in the dancing mist and the power of the water after dropping through the air. The following is what the Holy Spirit revealed in last Sunday's group discovery process.

Jesus was walking towards the Temple in Jerusalem and “Seeing a lone fig tree by the road, He came to it and found nothing on it except leaves only; and He *said to it, “No longer shall there ever be any fruit from you.” And at once the fig tree withered.” (Matthew 21:19) Jesus is comparing the fig as food as in the bread of life given to God's chosen people in the Torah. When the Jewish refused to believe in Jesus they no longer had fruit to give. This is a parable Jesus used to teach of his anger on the money exchanges and greed going on at the House of God. From a distance the temple appeared to be a place of worship. But it had become a place to take advantage of the worshipers who were in need of the elements of sacrifice according to the Law of Judah set forth for God's chosen nation of Jewish decent by the Torah. Greed was practiced over worship.

True worshipers would fall on their knees and their forehead would touch the ground as in kissing the feet of Jesus. Do we worship, as we will instinctively bow, upon the 2nd coming of Jesus?...as in Philippians 2:10-11... at the name of Jesus EVERY KNEE WILL BOW... and every tongue will confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father. Is there a resemblance of us to the money ex-changer? As Americans our abundance makes it a challenge to serve God before the life goal of obtaining wealth within our reach. We are becoming parched and withered-a process that happens without our knowing until it is too late. A visit to a 3rd world country is a wake-up call to discover people with uncomplicated lives who can give so much freely when they have so little. Here, there are movements in the 1000's to claim the Kingdom of God unlike life in America. People are accepting a life where there is certain persecution leading to death for believing in Jesus.

“The kingdom of heaven is like a treasure hidden in the field, which a man found and hid again; and from joy over it he goes and sells all that he has and buys that field.” (Matthew 13:44). God took the Disciple Making Workshop into the Kingdom of God that Jesus proclaimed to bring. “Jesus came into Galilee, preaching the gospel of God, and saying, "The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God is at hand; repent and believe in the gospel." Mark 1:14-15 The Holy Spirit enabled the class to discover the Kingdom of God as compared to the entrance to a cave of gold. They were given a taste of the riches God wants for all. And to what depth of wealth and riches unknown but so deep, one has no idea of its value. There was only one thing stranger than than the Word leading the group to personal discoveries to somewhere deep and heavy in abundant life. It's how these people can be walking out of the class saying they were “filled” without a trace of those meat sandwiches!
