God's Messages Are Not Always From Godly Sources

John 11:47-50 Amplified Bible (AMP)

So the chief priests and Pharisees convened a council (of the leaders in Israel), “What are we doing? For this man performs many signs (attesting miracles). If we let Him go on like this, everyone will believe in Him, and the Romans will come and take away both our (holy) place (the temple) and our nation.” But one of them, Caiaphas, who was the high priest that year (the year of Christ’s crucifixion), said to them, “You know nothing at all! Nor do you understand that it is expedient *and* politically advantageous for you that one man die for the people, and that the whole nation not perish.”

Numbers 22:28-35 (NASB)

And the Lord opened the mouth of the donkey, and she said to Balaam, “What have I done to you, that you have struck me these three times?” Then Balaam said to the donkey, “Because you have made a mockery of me! If there had been a sword in my hand, I would have killed you by now.” The donkey said to Balaam, “Am I not your donkey on which you have ridden all your life to this day? Have I ever been accustomed to do so to you?” And he said “No.”

Then the Lord opened the eyes of Balaam, and he saw the angel of the Lord standing in the way with his drawn sword in his hand; and he bowed all the way to the ground. The angel of the Lord said to him, “Why have you struck your donkey these three times? Behold, I have come out as an adversary, because your way was contrary to me. But the donkey saw me and turned aside from me these three times. If she had not turned aside from me, I would have surely have killed you just now, and let her live.” Balaam said to the angel of the Lord, “I have sinned, for I did not know that you were standing in the way against me. Now then, if it is displeasing to you, I will turn back.” But the angel of the Lord said to Balaam, “Go with the *men*, but you shall speak only the word which I tell you.” So Balaam went along with the leaders of Balak.

Caiaphas, the high priest unwittingly prophesied about Jesus role, the high priest was used by God as a prophet to show Jesus substitutionary death for sinners. Also, a lowly donkey was used by God to give a message to Balaam and subsequently to Balak who wanted him to use his magic to curse Israel. Messages of God come in numerous ways and through varied sources and it need not be audible either. With wisdom and discernment, we can be attentive and listen. "Be still and know that I am God".

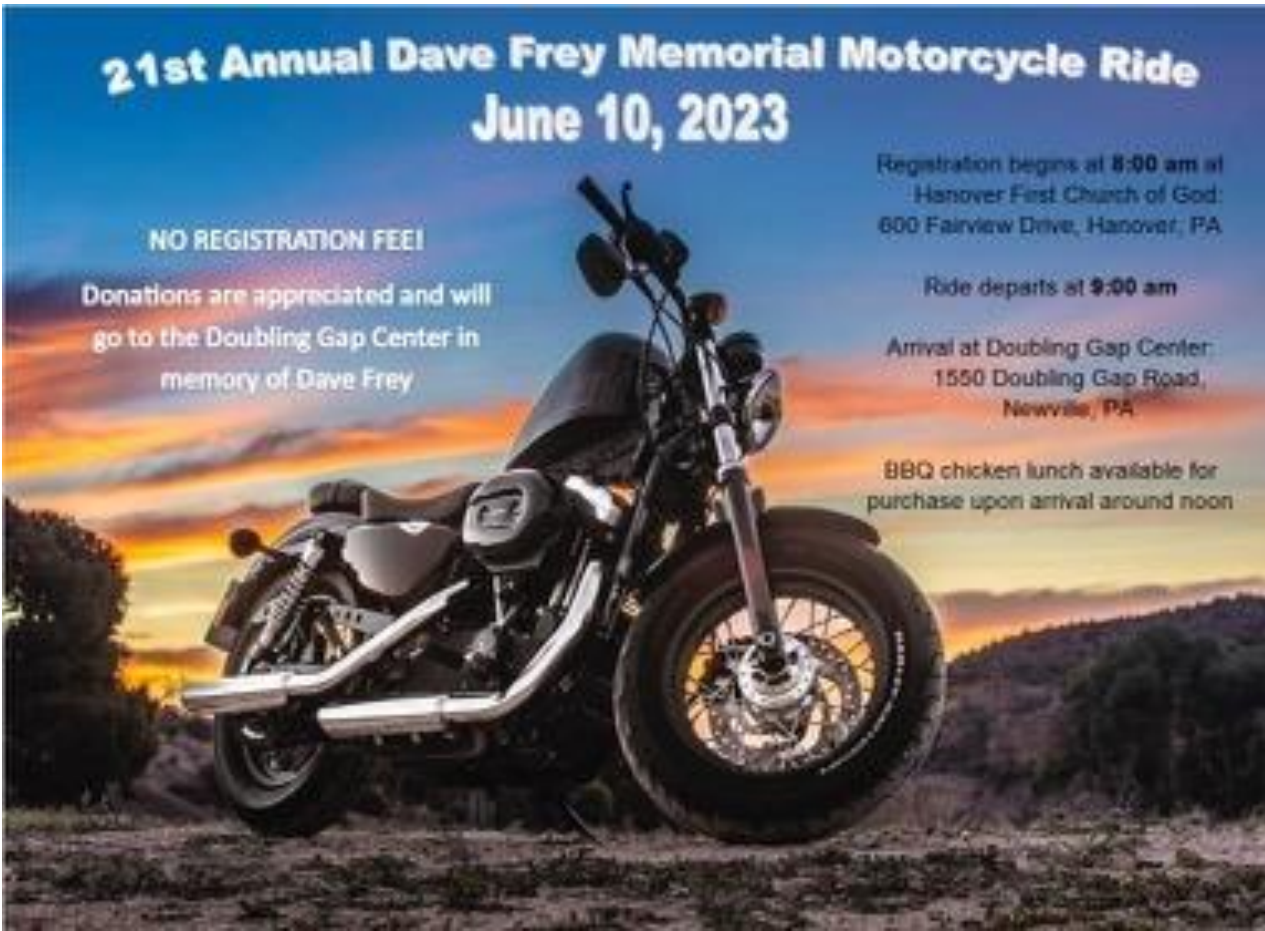
