### The Parable of the Sower

“.....He who has ears to hear, let Him hear.” Luke 8:8

Jesus traveled about from one town and village to another, proclaiming the good news of the kingdom of God. In this parable: “A farmer went out to sow his seed. As he was scattering the seed, some fell along the path; it was trampled on, and the birds ate it up. Some fell on rocky ground, and when it came up, the plants withered because they had no moisture. Other seed fell among thorns, which grew up with it and choked the plants. Still other seed fell on good soil. It came up and yielded a crop, a hundred times more than was sown.....” Luke 5-8 New International Version (NIV)

When he said this, he called out, “Whoever has ears to hear, let them hear.”..... His disciples asked him what this parable meant. He said, “The knowledge of the secrets of the kingdom of God has been given to you, but to others I speak in parables, so that, ‘though seeing, they may not see; though hearing, they may not understand.’ This is the meaning of the parable: The seed is the word of God. Those along the path are the ones who hear, and then the devil comes and takes away the word from their hearts, so that they may not believe and be saved. Those on the rocky ground are the ones who receive the word with joy when they hear it, but they have no root. They believe for a while, but in the time of testing they fall away. The seed that fell among thorns stands for those who hear, but as they go on their way they are choked by life’s worries, riches and pleasures, and they do not mature. But the seed on good soil stands for those with a noble and good heart, who hear the word, retain it, and by persevering produce a crop.” Luke 8:10-15 New International Version (NIV)

The son of God, created in the body of Jesus, brought the Kingdom of Heaven to earth for us. Jesus proclaimed “....The kingdom of heaven has come near (Mat 10:7).” ”For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life (John 3:16)”. Kingdom of Heaven is not only eternal life when we leave this world.

More important Jesus knows the perils of lifes worries, riches and pleasures that eventually become our idols over God. He gives us the keys to his Kingdom of Heaven. He offers a life having heaven on earth and a purpose. Which type of soil are You?

**“Path”** people don't stand a chance. The Word given is trampled on and stolen from their hearts....there is no love of God and his plan of salvation.

**“Rock”** people don't establish roots-a heart after God. Like many who followed Jesus believing the “good news” but never get around to doing anything about it. They wilt in time.

**“Thorn patch”** people who hear but as they go about their ways they are overcome by the worries of this world. They are consumed by the idols of pleasure and riches they have created from God's blessings and grace.

**“Good soil”** people who hear the word of God. Turn from their ways. Prioritize and keep balance in the Word to be a reflection of God's love. They persevere and share the “good news” while having heaven on earth.

## **RECIPE FOR THANKSGIVING**

### **ZUCCHINI BREAD**

3 eggs, beaten until foamy

2 cups sugar

3 cups flour

1 tsp baking soda

1 tbsp cinnamon

¼ tsp (generous) baking powder

1 tsp salt

1 cup raisins (optional)

1 cup vegetable oil

2 cups peeled and grated zucchini

1 tbsp vanilla

Half cup chopped nuts (optional)

Mix together eggs and dry ingredients. Add remaining ingredients mixing well, but do not beat. Divide batter into 2 large greased loaf pans. Bake at 350 degrees approximately 1 hour or until toothpick comes out clean. Makes 2 loaves.

### **Scroll Food**

*So I went to the angel and said to him, "Give me the little book." And he said to me, "Take and eat it." **Revelation 10:9***

On two occasions in the Bible, God prepared scroll food for his prophets. The first was when He gave Ezekiel a scroll with writings on both sides, probably because the Lord had so much to say. Ezekiel ate it and found it as sweet as honey, though the message included words of judgment for Judah. It was still God's Word, and, as one commentary says, "the sweetness came from the source of the words." The apostle John had a similar experience in Revelation 10:8-11. His scroll, too, tasted as sweet as honey.

The Bible is often compared to food, to bread, to milk, to meat, and to nourishment. It is the proper diet for the inner self, and it's necessary to keep us from spiritual starvation. People today are starving for spiritual truth, but many aren't even aware they are hungry. There is a famine of the hearing of the Word of God (Amos 8:11).

One of the best ways to stimulate the appetite of others is letting them see how much you enjoy your daily bread. Keep an open Bible nearby all the time. Read it frequently. Quote it often. Trust it always. And find every opportunity to share the Bread of Life with others.
