RECIPE for Bread of Life The makings for a Disciple of Jesus

- Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is near..." (Mat 4:17). This was the first message Jesus preached. 1)
Repent is to turn from our fleshly pleasures. Seek to know God and his righteousness.
2) "Come to me, all who are weary...and you will find rest for you soul." (Mat 11:28-29)

Each of you be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ. Symbolically, by immersion into the water we bury our old self and sinful ways. Accepting the Savior-God become man bloodshed that washes away sin. We rise out of the water transformed into a new life that allows us to stand in His Presence.

- 1) Acknowledging Jesus as the Savior for all so everyone can be reunited to God.
- 2) Receive the Holy Spirit and spiritual ears to understand the Word of God.

Commit to follow as the 12 disciples. They memorized what Jesus taught, by their discipline we have the written word of God today, aka the Holy Bible. "Follow Me, and I will make you fishers of men." (Mat 4:18-20) To follow is to obey everything Jesus did.

- 1) Total submission to love God and love thy neighbor. "He who has ears...." (has a heart to seek Gods' Will..... will be given spiritual ears to) "...let him hear." (Mathew 4:17)
- 2) Total mastery of Jesus teaching. "To you it has been granted to know the mysteries of the kingdom of heaven, but to them it has not been granted. (Matthew 13:9-11)

Intimate relationship with God. "Greater love hath no man (God in the flesh as Jesus) than this....." (John 15:13). Jesus got up at daybreak to pray to His Father-our God! Find your solitary quiet time to read the Bible. At first, it may seem difficult but your faith will prompt God to reveal his truths to you. "How much more will your Father in heaven give the Holy Spirit to those who ask him!" (Luke 11:13)

Pray to become a Prayer Warrior against Satan. Prayer protects us by the blood of the Lamb of God.
"Don't give place to the devil." (to create a barrier to our Heaven on Earth). (Ephesians 4:27).
"Worship the Lord with gladness; come before him with joyful songs." (Psalms 100:2).

Eternity starts today. Jesus brought the Kingdom of God to earth for everyone. Jesus said to them, "I am the bread of life; he who comes to Me will not hunger, and he who believes in Me will never thirst. (John 6:35)

But be forewarned the invitation won't last forever. We insult God who has given his all in all in order that we may be heirs to his Kingdom when we make our lives more important than following his call. Consider

the parable of the Great Banquet “Blessed is the one who will eat at the feast in the kingdom of God.”..... “But they all alike began to make excuses (to not come-follow). I tell you, not one of those who were invited will get a taste of my banquet.” (Luke 14:15-24).

The ax is at the root of the tree...”Cut it down! Why should it use up the soil?” (Luke 13:6-9)

God, Himself, in the person of Jesus, came to earth to suffer as the Messiah to save us from our sin. Romans 5:8...”But God shows and clearly proves His [own] love for us by the fact that while we were still sinners, Christ (the Messiah, the Anointed One) died for us.” How great is our God? Jesus proclaimed “...The Kingdom of Heaven has come near (Mat 10:7).” In Acts 2:38 “... Peter answered them, Repent (change your views and purpose to accept the will of God in your inner selves instead of rejecting it) and be baptized, every one of you, in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of and release from your sins; and you shall receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.” By accepting the salvation Jesus offers The Spirit of Jesus (the Holy Spirit) lives upon our hearts. The 12 apostles did not have the Holy Spirit within them. They were from the old school of hard knocks where they first followed Jesus as their Master-as disciples. Their life was total submission to everything Jesus said and taught. Without their discipline to remember and pass down the Truths Jesus taught we would not have the Bread of Life-the Word of God to keep our residency in God's Kingdom. Romans 14:17 “[After all] the kingdom of God is not a matter of [getting the] food and drink [one likes], but instead it is righteousness (that state which makes a person acceptable to God) and [heart] peace and joy in the Holy Spirit.” Upon entering into the Kingdom of God., we have a life, now, as in having Heaven on earth. It is not a physical thing like food and water but a spiritual realization that Jesus taught “Thy Kingdom come, Thy will be done, On earth as it is in heaven...” (Matthew 6:10)

The “RECIPE” highlights the necessary ingredients to the keys of the Kingdom.

The aroma of fresh baked bread plays on our sense of smell and makes us hungry for bread. Just like the aroma of bread appears when we follow a recipe so does the feeling of peace, joy and hope follow as we surrender to the spirit of God. The bread of life is the “Word of God”. Both breads sustain life but only the bread of life provides for eternal life. Both breads require a discipline to follow in order to obtain it. Both satisfy our hunger but the bread of life will open doors to the Kingdom of God and help us to share the faith in this world that sets the captives free. A disciple is simply a follower of a teacher. As a disciple of Jesus, you will receive the help of the Holy Spirit to make more disciples. The Holy Spirit of God helps us to discover the extent of God's love for us. Discover for yourself in the “RECIPE” what it takes to know God as the Savior-King and as a disciple of Jesus to bring to all who will turn to Him a fresh and abundant life here on earth and throughout eternity. The recipe to having the Kingdom of God is to become a disciple. It is impossible to live our life on earth in appreciation of God's suffering for his people without being part of the Kingdom. It is also impossible to be a part of the Kingdom without being a disciple!

Merriam-Webster Dictionary defines carnal: ex : relating to or given to crude bodily pleasures and appetites gluttony and other carnal activities b : marked by sexuality carnal love 2 : bodily, corporeal seen with carnal eyes 3a : temporal carnal weapons the superiority of the spiritual and eternal over the carnal. Romans 8:7-11 7[That is] because the mind of the flesh [with its carnal thoughts and purposes] is hostile to God, for it does not submit itself to God's Law; indeed it cannot. 8So then those who are living the life of the flesh [catering to the appetites and impulses of their carnal nature] cannot please or satisfy God, or be acceptable to Him. 9But you are not living the life of the flesh, you are living the life of the Spirit, if the [Holy] Spirit of God [really] dwells within you [directs and controls you]. But if anyone does not possess the [Holy] Spirit of Christ, he is none of His [he does not belong to Christ, is not truly a child of God]. 10But if Christ lives in you, [then although] your [natural] body is dead by reason of sin and guilt, the spirit is alive because of [the] righteousness [that He imputes to you]. 11And if the Spirit of Him Who raised up Jesus from the dead dwells in you, [then] He Who raised up Christ Jesus from the dead will also restore to life your mortal (short-lived, perishable) bodies through His Spirit Who dwells in you.

As Paul Harvey would say, "Now for the rest of the story." This world we live in where we are prone to trip and fall is the given domain of darkness. God in his perfect plan uses darkness to groom us to be disciples. Let's remember how following Jesus will help us. In the beginning of Matthew, we see the darkness at work in The Temptation of Jesus story. "1Then Jesus was led up by the Spirit into the wilderness to be tempted by the devil. 2And after He had fasted forty days and forty nights, He then became hungry. 3And the tempter came and said to Him, "If You are the Son of God, command that these stones become bread." 4But He answered and said, "It is written, 'MAN SHALL NOT LIVE ON BREAD ALONE, BUT ON EVERY WORD THAT PROCEEDS OUT OF THE MOUTH OF GOD.'" (Matthew 4:1-4)

My parting thought is when darkness comes at you causing doubt remember John, the Baptist that was in prison. John sitting in prison after Jesus had finished giving instructions to His twelve disciples wondered why he wasn't out in the harvest. Whenever we doubt our salvation, disciple-making or even God, Jesus's words to John should help us be aware that darkness is at work with the only power he has-deception. "Jesus answered and said to them, "Go and report to John what you hear and see: 5the BLIND RECEIVE SIGHT and the lame walk, the lepers are cleansed and the deaf hear, the dead are raised up, and the POOR HAVE THE GOSPEL PREACHED TO THEM. 6" And blessed is he who does not take offense at Me." (Matthew 11:4-6) When doubt sets in remember what the spoken word of God-the Bread of Life, the Bible says of all the works (eye witnessed) that was "heard and seen" done by Jesus. Instead of turning away. Repent and turn to Jesus-the yeast of the bread of life. It is the #1 ingredient to having the Bread of Life.
