## A Time to Remember

The fast pace of summer with so many things to do and places to go has left us a memory, a fresh impression of the things we strive for and who we like to share our quality time with. As Thanksgiving Day approaches, taking time to give “Thanks be to God” may remind us if we’re “staying on course” in our walk of faith. We remember our past preparations with sharing a turkey or a favorite dish with all the trimmings with family and friends. The memories can almost bring back the warmth and smells of the feast. We hardly recover from all Thanksgiving brings to the table when the countdown to Christmas begins. Communion would be a gathering to honor and remembering Jesus. In the Roman Catholic Church a priest who is deemed qualified and versed invites the church to partake in The Last Supper/Holy Communion. The practice of transubstantiation is believed to convert the substance (bread and wine) of the Eucharistic elements into the “real” body and blood of Christ at consecration as defined by Christian Theology. A quick search in the dictionary of 2 reference Bibles for the meaning of “communion“ did not even show the word. Makes me wonder if “communion“ is even mentioned in the Holy Bible, at all. More than a discrepancy with Holy Communion and why Luther (of the Reformation) rejected the Roman Catholic view is their belief in the repeated sacrifices of Christ as seen on Catholic crosses with the crucified Jesus still hanging. There are 2 or 3 other popular beliefs in what happens with the bread

and wine. The other end of the spectrum would be the elements are symbolic of the body and blood of Jesus.

In order to share and give hope from the last several months seeking Gods' Word to prepare a funeral service and to encourage in blizzard situations and etc. I'm going to put the "cart before the horse" to elaborate on "life after death" before "remembering Jesus" as the bread broken so that we may have life after death. The hope is to connect to how God is telling of his love for us before the sacrifice He makes. An act of sacrificial love to give us redemption from our sin. I will share scriptures on "life after death" in our new bodies before returning to "the breaking of bread in remembrance of Jesus." I feel with putting the cart before the horse contrary to the natural sequence of events or doing it the Wong Way, I can avoid debating views on communion. And practice "breaking bread in remembrance of Jesus." At the time, I was praying Gods' council and comfort for a close friend whose Love had passed too soon.

From Abraham-The Father of All Nations throughout the Gospels when Gods Word was spoken by Jesus and recorded by in the Holy Bible and Revelations. All he is asking is to believe in Him. He wants to be our God...how cool is that ...He accepts us just the way we are. Remembering His unconditional love when we have reached the lowest point in our life is saving grace. He knows that we will realize His great love once we trust Him to be our God. His love for us at cross is given for all who will receive it. I feel like I'm throwing scripture which is actually Gods' Word for his people, at the reader. I apologize if this is offensive but I don't think I can say it any better than the original author.

In The Valley of Dry Bones God describes how He will rise us from the grave. And give us a land to live-Yahweh and My people (us). 1The hand of the LORD was on me, and He brought me out by His Spirit and set me down in the middle of the valley; it was full of bones. 2He led me all around them. There were a great many of them on the surface of the valley, and they were very dry. 3Then He said to me, "Son of man, can these bones live?" I replied, "Lord GOD, only You know." 4He said to me, "Prophesy concerning these bones and say to them: Dry bones, hear the word of the Lord! 5This is what the Lord God says to these bones: I will cause breath to enter you, and you will live. 6I will put tendons on you, make flesh grow on you, and cover you with skin. I will put breath in you so that you come to life. Then you will know that I am Yahweh." 7So I prophesied as I had been commanded. While I was prophesying, there was a noise, a rattling sound, and the bones came together, bone to bone. 8As I looked, tendons appeared on them, flesh grew, and skin covered them, but there was no breath in them. He said to me, "Prophesy to the breath, prophesy, son of man. Say to it: This is what the Lord God says: Breath, come from the four winds and breathe into these slain so that they may live!" So I prophesied as He commanded me; the breath entered them, and they came to life and stood on their feet, a vast army. 11Then he said to me, "Son of man, these bones are the whole house of Israel. Look how they say, 'Our bones are dried up, and our hope has perished; we are cut off.' 12Therefore, prophesy and say to them: This is what the Lord God says: I am going to open your graves and bring you up from them, My people, and lead you into the land of Israel. 13You will know that I am Yahweh, My people, when I open your graves and bring you up from them. 14I will put My Spirit in you, and you will live, and I will settle you in your own land. Then

you will know that I am Yahweh. I have spoken, and I will do it.” This is the declaration of the Lord. Ezekiel 37:1-14 HCSB

In the Splendor of the heavenly bodies God has a plan to let our earthly body die and He will give us a new body with the splendor heavenly bodies. He wants each different "How are the dead raised? What kind of body will they have when they come? " What you sow does not come to life unless it dies. 37 you are not sowing the future body, but only a seed,. 38But God gives it a body as He wants, and to each of the seeds its own body. 40There are heavenly bodies and earthly bodies, but the splendor of the heavenly bodies is different from that of the earthly ones. sown in weakness, raised in power; 44sown a natural body, raised a spiritual body. If there is a natural body, there is also a spiritual body. 45So it is written: The first man Adam became a living being; the last Adam became a life-giving Spirit. 46However, the spiritual is not first, but the natural, then the spiritual. 47The first man was from the earth and made of dust; the second man is[a] from heaven. 48Like the man made of dust, so are those who are made of dust; like the heavenly man, so are those who are heavenly. 49And just as we have borne the image of the man made of dust, we will also bear the image of the heavenly man. Death has been swallowed up in victory. 55Death, where is your victory? Death, where is your sting? 56Now the sting of death is sin, and the power of sin is the law. 57But thanks be to God, who gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ! 1 Corinthians 15:21-56 HCSB

In Our Future after Death then we will have a resurrected body from God...perhaps like Jesus? For we know that if our temporary, earthly dwelling (our body like a tent) is destroyed then we have a resurrected body from God, a body in the heavens, not made with human hands. 2Indeed, we groan in this body, desiring to put on our dwelling (to be in our new body) from heaven , 3When we are clothed (with a body) we will not be found naked (only in spirit). 4Indeed, we groan while we are in this body, burdened as we are, because we do not want to be unclothed but clothed, so that mortality may be swallowed up by life. 5And the One who prepared us for this very purpose is God, who gave us the Spirit as a down payment. 6So, we are always confident and know that while we are at home in the (human) body we are away from the Lord. 7For we walk by faith, not by sight, 8and we are confident and satisfied to be out of the body and at home with the Lord. 9Therefore, whether we are at home or away, we make it our aim to be pleasing to Him. 10For we must all appear before the tribunal of Christ, so that each may be repaid for what he has done in the body, whether good or worthless. II Corinthians 5:1-10 HCSB

In We get new Bodies. Yes, definitely like Jesus' glorious body...the Lord Jesus, the Messiah.... will make them like his glorious body. ## **FROM THE CHAIRMAN OF THE BOARD**

MJM Board of Directors Nominations

It's time to nominate members in good standing to serve on the MJM Board of Directors. Nominations must be received in writing by Fred McClincy, B.O.D. Chairman, by October 1, 2022. You can email the member/s name/s and a brief explanation why you believe they should serve on the Board of Directors to Fred at 215-234-8611 or email it to Fred at [bikerfredz@gmail.com](mailto:bikerfredz@gmail.com) . Please speak to the person(s) you are considering nominating to be sure they are in agreement to serve on the MJM Board. Members may not nominate themselves. Posted from MJM’s Handbook on the qualifications for Board Members:

Motorcyclists for Jesus Ministries will be governed by a Board of Directors. All corporate powers shall be exercised by or under the direction of the Board of Directors.

The Board of Directors will be current riders whose experience, expertise, and wisdom are essential to the Motorcyclists for Jesus Ministries.

Nominations for the Board of Directors will be made in writing by any member, other than the nominee, to bring his or her name before the Board for consideration to be put before the general membership for a vote. All nominations should be in the hands of the Chairperson of the Board of Directors no later than October 1. This deadline will be published in the August and September issues of the T.E.A.M VOICE. The nominee must have been a member in good standing with MJM for a minimum of two (2) years. The member making the nomination shall include a brief biography and reasons why he or she believes the nominee would be a good board member. The Board of Directors shall then approve, or disapprove the nomination. Nominations will be considered with regard to geographical location. If approved by the Board, ballots for the nominee(s) shall be mailed individually to each member to approve their choice of nominees.

Elected Directors may serve for two (2) consecutive three (3) year terms. However, they must be elected by the membership for each of those terms. Director may appoint a member to fill a Board position resulting from an individual not meeting attendance requirements, resignation, or death. The appointee will hold office until the next election of the Board of Directors. Completing a vacated term does not count as the first of two (2) consecutive terms. Decisions of the Board will be determined by a simple majority vote.

The Board of Directors shall consist of at least four (4) elected members, but not more than seven (7) plus the Chaplain/Educational Director. The Chaplain/Educational Director will be an ex-officio member of the Board. He or she will also be involved in the administrative functions of the Ministry. A Chairperson of the Board will be elected annually by the Board of Directors. The Chairperson of the Board may vote only to break a tie.

The Board of Directors, each being born-again, loyal Christians, will focus attention to all Motorcyclists for Jesus Ministries programs and activities, to assure that all programs and activities reflect a loyalty to the gospel of Jesus Christ, and that all programs and activities will have an evangelistic outreach to lead motorcyclists to a saving knowledge of Jesus Christ and to a true worship experience. The Board of Directors will establish governing policies, appoint and approve the Chaplain/Educational Director, Officers and Road Representatives, and prescribe activity guidelines.

All officers and Road Representatives, with the exception of the Board of Directors, will be reappointed annually for the ensuing year upon review and approval by the Board of Directors.

The Board of Directors will hold a minimum of two (2) meetings per year. The time, place, and means of such meetings will be determined by the Board of Directors. A Director may be represented by proxy at only one (1) meeting per Fiscal year April 1st through March 31st, unless a valid reason acceptable to the Board was in evidence. If a Director misses two (2) Board meetings without a prior valid excuse that would be accepted by the Board, he/she would be removed from the Board of

Directors. Absent Directors would keep attending Board members from having a quorum and thus unable to have a legal meeting. Decisions on special issues may be made by use of Fax, E-Mail, or telephone through polling each Director. To constitute a quorum, meeting would require that two-thirds (2/3) of the total Board of Directors be present.

A majority vote of the Board is required to remove an officer or Board member, when it has been determined and documented that the individual in question has not conducted themselves or represented the ministry of the “Motorcyclists for Jesus Ministries” according to the guidelines as presented in the most recent Membership Handbook. Prior to the vote, the individual whose conduct is in question must be contacted by the Chairperson and be given the opportunity to speak directly to the Board Members at a meeting of the Board. **An opportunity for MJM members to speak on the individual’s behalf or support the individual’s position to the Board shall be provided. The Board is to consult with all MJM Officers with knowledge of the events surrounding the conduct in question and consider their input as a final decision is made by a majority vote of the Board.**

The Board of Directors may remove from the membership rolls any MJM member for misconduct. A hearing will be granted to that member by the Board of Directors to determine final judgement.

If a member wants to speak at a Directors’ meeting, he/she must notify the Chairperson in writing to be put on the agenda no less than one week prior to the meeting. The guest member will be allotted five (5) minutes to present his/her topic.

Each year the Board of Directors will conduct an audit of all National financial records of Motorcyclists for Jesus Ministries. An audit summary will be printed in the T.E.A.M. VOICE, the national newsletter, annually for the prior year. Motorcyclists for Jesus Ministries will keep records and file reports with the IRS on a fiscal year ending March 31. Except as otherwise specially determined by resolution of the Board of Directors, or as otherwise required by law, checks, drafts, promissory notes, orders for payments of money, and other evidence of indebtedness of the corporation shall be signed by the Treasurer and any other authorized member (two signatures, not within the same household).

Directors will donate their time and shall not receive a salary for their services as Board members or officers of this ministry.

Three-fourth (3/4) of the total Board of Directors must be present to change, rewrite, or cancel any part of this handbook.

Thank you for participating in this process. MJM is a self-governning ministry and depends on the participation of ALL its members.

MJM Board is excepting Nominations for the following Awards, Missionary of the Year:

Founders Award, Pappy's TEAM Award, and the Servants Award. MJM Members can nominate other members and/or TEAM's for these Awards to be given to Fred McClincy. Nominations must be received in writing by Fred McClincy, Board of Directors Chairman, by October 1, 2022.

Listed below is an explanation of the MJM Appreciation Award, MJM Servants Award, MJM Founders Award, Pappy's TEAM, and MJM Missionary of the Year Award:

MJM Appreciation Award - for serving the members of Motorcyclists For Jesus Ministries with your talents at our Annual Spring Kick-Off "And I saw as it were a sea of glass mingled with fire: and them that had gotten the victory over the beast, and over his image, and over his mark, and over the number of his name, stand on the sea of glass, having the harps of God."
